

ADOBE LOGIN – NAMED USER LICENSE

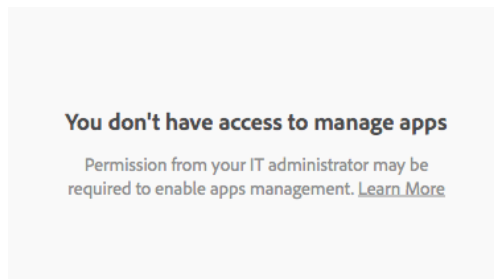
Adobe Named User License (NUL) is for Humber employees who wish to use Adobe products on Humber laptops or on home computers for work-related activities.

Acquiring an Adobe NUL

Important: Before installing the 2019 Creative Cloud Desktop App (CCDA) please uninstall all previous versions of Adobe products or you will receive the following message:



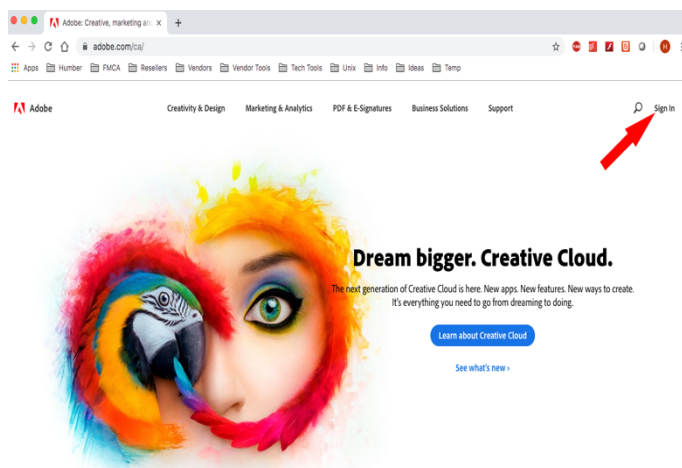

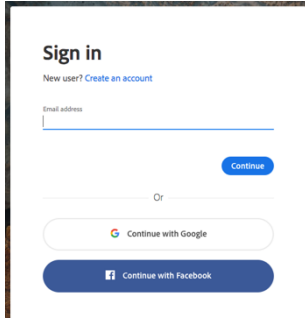

Installation with CCDA Not Pre-Installed:

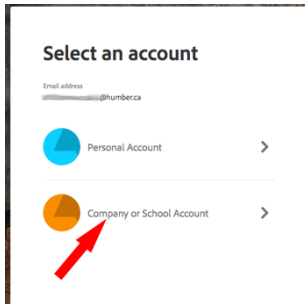
You can make an appointment with FMCATech to have the Humber Adobe CCDA installed (Humber laptop only) or follow these steps:



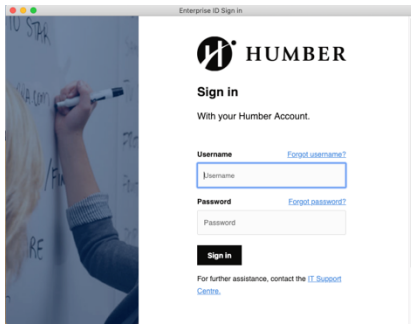
1. Visit <https://www.adobe.com/ca/> and click "Sign In".



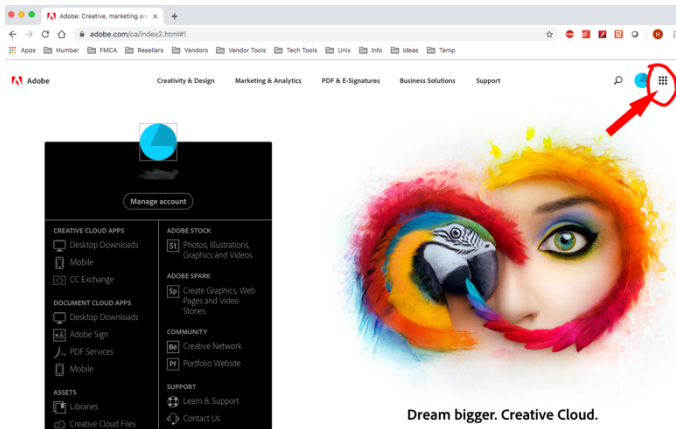
2. Enter your Humber email address and click “Continue”.



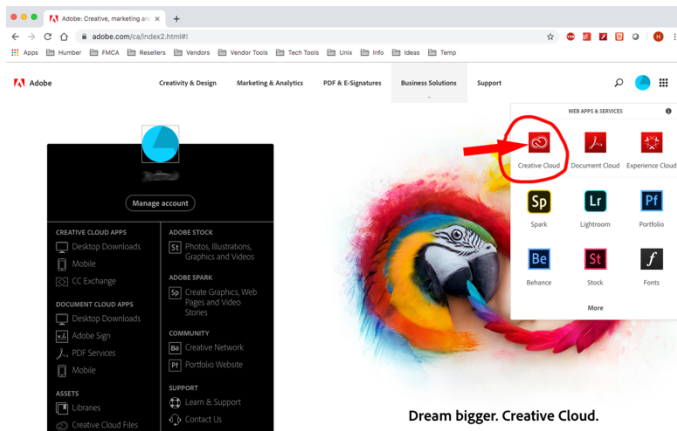
3. Click “Company or School Account”.



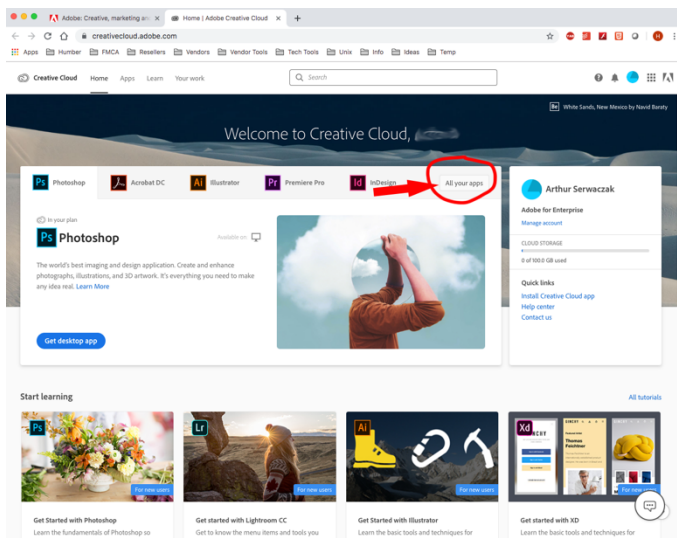
4. Sign in with your Humber ID credentials.



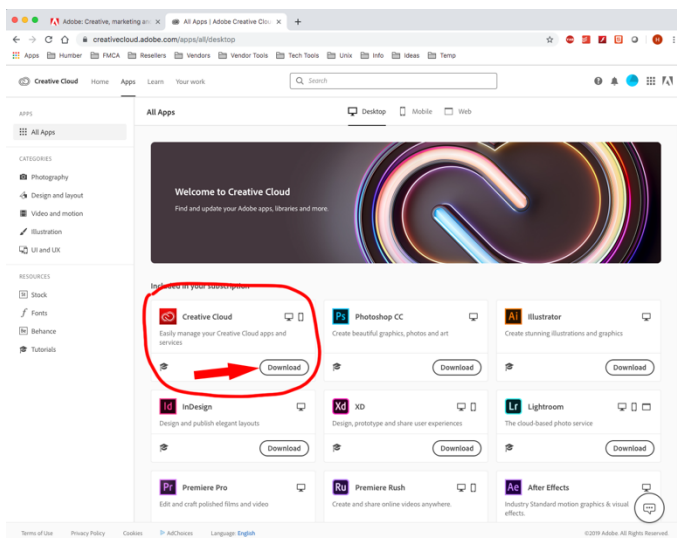
5. Click on the waffle icon in top right-hand corner.



6. Click on the “Creative Cloud” icon.



7. Click on “All your apps” link.

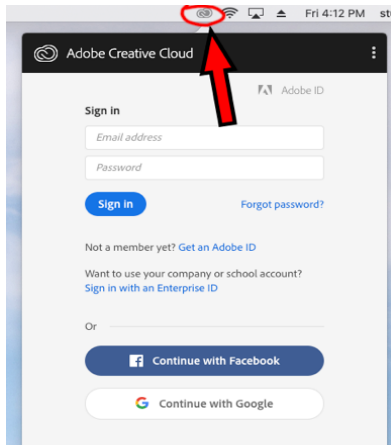


8. Under “Creative Cloud” click “Download”.

This will download the CCDA. Once the download is complete, open the file and install the CCDA. When the CCDA is installed and opened, the rest of the apps will be available to download through the desktop application. Refer to the next section for using the CCDA.

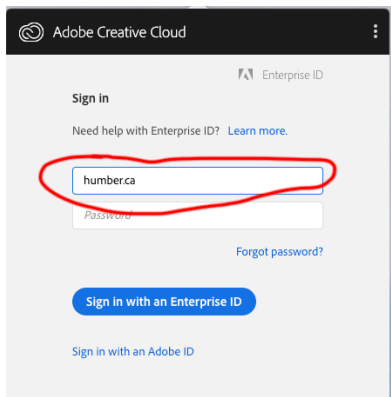
Installation with CCDA Pre-Installed:

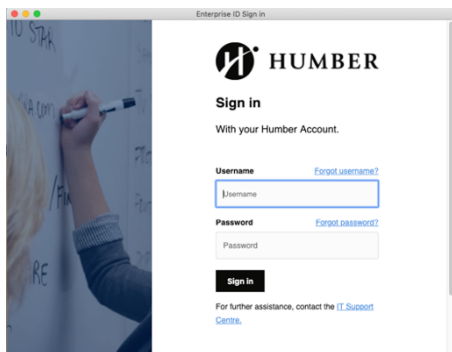


1. Launch the Adobe Desktop App by clicking the desktop icon (in the start menu on windows)

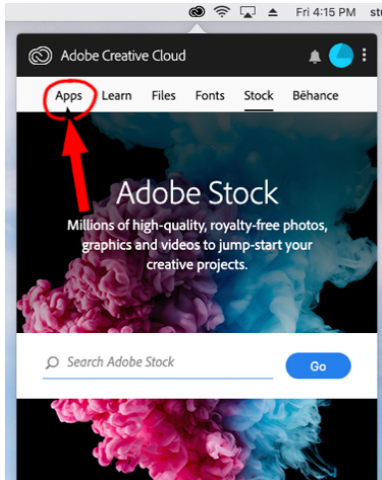
2. Click on "Sign in with an Enterprise ID" in blue writing on Fig. 1



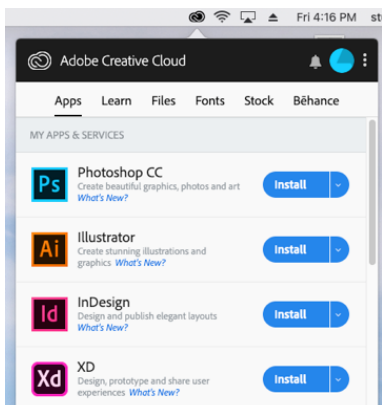
3. Type in "humber.ca" in the Email address or domain name field.
